IT IS ORDERED that the requirements of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(a) and 23(b)(1) are satisfied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following class is hereby certified as to the Class Claims (as defined in the Parties' Stipulation):

All participants and beneficiaries in the Yale-New Haven Hospital and Tax Exempt Affiliates Tax Sheltered Annuity Plan at any time on or after January 21, 2016 and continuing to the date of judgment, or such earlier date that the Court determines is appropriate and just (the "Class Period"), including any beneficiary of a deceased

person who was a participant in the Plan at any time during the Class Period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs Kaity Ruilova and Eileen Brannigan are appointed as Class representatives and Miller Shah LLP and Capozzi Adler, P.C. are appointed as Class counsel.
